With the recent flurry of information regarding the Coronavirus, we wanted to take this opportunity to share some information regarding changes we're making to our giving procedures. When we resume worship services, we will make a subtle change to the offering time. Instead of passing offering plates, we will have baskets located at the rear of the sanctuary for you to place your gifts on the way out. This is intended to help limit the amount of physical contact.

We would like to remind everyone that we have an electronic giving option available via ACH. If you are interested, forms are located at the Welcome Desk. You can fill out a form, attach a voided check, and drop it in the giving baskets, drop it off, or mail it to the church office. You can elect to have your gift withdrawn from your account on the 5th and/or 20th of the month for your convenience. In addition, PayPal is available for electronic giving, but please be aware that PayPal keeps a percentage of your gift, so if you want to ensure that all of your gift is directed to the ministry of the church, please consider the ACH option.

A number of you already use the "Bill Pay" service from your bank, which mails a check directly to the church. This may be a good option also if your bank charges a modest fee or provides this service free of charge.

As always, you can continue to give via cash or check on Sunday mornings. We will be taking extra precautions for our counters who come into direct contact with cash and checks to ensure their safety.
