### Health & Safety Policies Post Covid Pandemic

As Montrose Zion Christian Preschool continues to welcome your child for the remainder of the 2021/2022 school year, we want you to know we are still doing everything we can to ensure the safety of your child and your family. We want to create an environment where you feel safe leaving your child and where your child feels safe and loved with us. Please take time to read carefully all of our new Health and Safety Policies and Procedures we have updated.

- \* Hand-washing will still occur at drop off, throughout the morning, at all transitions, and at pick-up for staff and all students.
- \* Purell Sanitizer will still be used when a sink is not available.
- \* Cleaning and disinfecting will still be conducted continuously throughout the morning.
- \* Masks are optional for all students and staff. We do ask you have a clean mask available for your child either in their backpack or with your child's teacher. We will require any student with a persistent cough or runny nose to wear a mask throughout our morning.
- \* We will still be requiring that families utilize lobby drop-off and pick-up. Please call ahead when picking up early or dropping off late. **You are now always welcome to come down to the classrooms at any time.**
- \* We will still be performing temperature screenings on teachers and children each morning at drop-off. Anyone with a temperature above 100 degrees Fahrenheit will be asked to return home for 48 hours. We will use no-touch infrared thermometers.
- \* If your child has a fever or any signs of illness, we ask that they stay home until they've been symptom-free without medication for at least 48 hours. If you choose to keep your child home, just call the church and let us know.
- \* Children still have their own caddy of school supplies to use throughout the morning.
- \* Individual plastic desk shield will still be utilized during snack time.
- \* Disposable plates, cups and utensils will still be used at snack time. Staff always wear gloves when preparing food.
